The Capital Appeal Grant Committee is pleased to announce 12 of 13 final Capital Appeal Grants: \$25,000 grant to *Friends of Fumbelo* to aid in their work with the women and children of the village of Fumbelo, particularly education-related projects and aid. \$20,000 grant to *Family Promise* to support their LIFE (Local Initiative for Family Empowerment) initiative that helps clients avoid homelessness. \$2,000 grants to the following Service Ministry partner organizations: *Wellesley ABC, Friends of Wellesley METCO, Chaplains on the Way, OUT Metrowest, NWW Committee for Community Living, Common Cathedral/Ecclesia Ministries, Hope and Comfort, A Place to Turn, Partakers, The Human Relations Service (HRS)*. The final grant distribution will be announced in the fall.




Come, O Fount of Every Blessing




1 Come, O Fount of ev-ery bless-ing, tune my heart to sing your grace;
