Soup is LOVE!

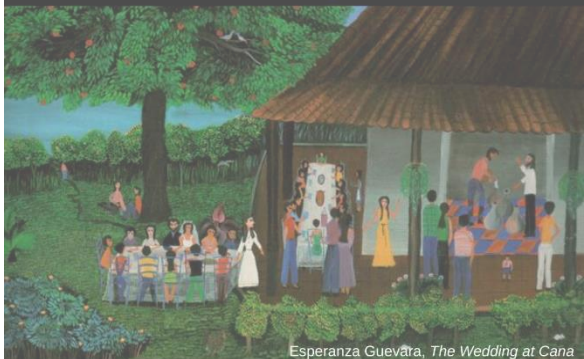
