

## Spirit Lead Me

"What are you doing here, Elijah?" That's the question God asked Elijah, and it's a question we all wrestle with at times. Your pastors invite you to join us on a Lenten journey of discernment and discovery. "Spirit Lead Me" is a small group study, centered in scripture, and grounded in the reality that if we are willing to listen, there is always something for us to hear. We will gather four times in small groups to pray, read scripture, and help one another think about that simple, profound question: why are you here?


