


Chapel in the Pines A Wild Church Worship Service



Please join us for the first Wild Church worship service!

Once a month we will offer the opportunity to gather for worship out in nature. This new monthly service, Chapel in the Pines, will take place at a recreational town park in Wellesley which is surrounded by forest. At Chapel in the Pines we will experience God in nature through prayer, scripture and short meditative walks in the forest. Refreshments will be served after the service.

This service is part of the Wild Church Movement which began in 2016 with the formation of the Wild Church Network. Since then, Wild Church communities have been popping up all over the US and Canada. We believe this will be the first Wild Church community in the state of MA!

What is Wild Church?

A Wild Church is a community of people who gather outdoors to worship and connect with God through experiences with nature. Wild Church communities seek to discover how God is revealed through the trees, the birds, the wind and the earth. Wild Church offers a time to experience the splendor of God's creation and praise God for the beauty of the earth.

What: Chapel in the Pines – A Monthly Wild Church Worship Service

When: Sunday, October 17th from 3:00 to 4:00 pm

Where: MacKinnon Park, Wellesley (The entrance to the park is located at the corner of Halsey Ave and MacArthur Ave)

Please...

- Park on the forest side of Turner Street (near the entrance to Morse's Pond) then walk down Halsey Ave. to McKinnon Park. This is a 5-10 minute walk.
- Bring a lawn chair or blanket to sit on.
- Bring bug spray and a water bottle.
- Wear casual, weather appropriate clothing and sturdy walking shoes.
- Try to arrive 10 minutes early so we can begin right at 3:00
